AEIMC Statement of Faith

01 **The Trinity**

We believe in one God, eternally existent in three persons: God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit. These three are co-equal and co-eternal, having the same nature, power, and glory.

02 **Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord**

We believe that Jesus Christ is the only begotten Son of God, conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary. He lived a sinless life, died on the cross for our sins, was buried, and rose again on the third day, ascending into heaven. He is the only way to salvation, and through faith in Him, we are reconciled to God.

03 **The Authority of Scripture**

We believe that the Bible, consisting of the Old and New Testaments, is the inspired, infallible, and authoritative Word of God. It is the final authority in all matters of faith, doctrine, and conduct.

04 **Salvation through Grace**

We believe that salvation is by grace through faith in Jesus Christ alone. It is not earned by good works but is a gift of God to those who believe in Christ's atoning sacrifice for sin.

05 **The Holy Spirit's Work**

We believe in the present ministry of the Holy Spirit, who convicts the world of sin, righteousness, and judgment. The Holy Spirit regenerates, sanctifies, and empowers believers for godly living and service, and bestows spiritual gifts for the edification of the Church.

AEIMC Statement of Faith (contd.)

06 **The Church**

We believe that the Church is the body of Christ, made up of believers from every nation, tribe, and tongue. The Church's mission is to glorify God, preach the gospel, and disciple believers for works of service.

07 **The Return of Christ**

We believe in the imminent return of our Lord Jesus Christ to judge the living and the dead. His return will be physical, visible, and personal. The righteous will receive eternal life, and the unrighteous eternal separation from God.

08 **The Resurrection of the Dead**

We believe in the bodily resurrection of all people: believers to eternal life in heaven and unbelievers to eternal judgment in hell.

09 **Baptism and the Lord's Supper**

We believe in two ordinances instituted by Christ: Baptism and the Lord's Supper. Baptism by immersion symbolizes the believer's identification with the death, burial, and resurrection of Jesus. The Lord's Supper is a commemoration of Christ's sacrifice on the cross and His promise to return.

10 **Living a Life of Holiness**

We believe that all believers are called to live lives of holiness, set apart for God, rejecting sin, and walking in the fruit of the Spirit. Through Christ's redemptive work and the power of the Holy Spirit, believers are enabled to live victorious lives that reflect the character of Christ.
